If a water access licence is granted, the *Water Management Act 2000* requires that various details relating to the water access licence are to be recorded in the Water Access Licence Register kept by the Minister. Information recorded in the Water Access Licence Register is publicly available.



Guide to the application for a new water access licence with a zero share component

Application under section 61 (1) (b) of the *Water Management Act 2000*

Introduction

This guide is provided to assist you in completing the *Application for a new water access licence with a zero share component*.

A water access licence (WAL) entitles its holder to specified shares in the available water within a specified water management area or from a specified water source (the share component), and to take water at specified times, at specified rates or in specified circumstances, or in any combination of these, and in specified areas or from specified locations (the extraction component).

The website www.dwe.nsw.gov.au provides more information on water access licences.

In the case of a WAL with a zero share component, the holder does not have a right to a share of available water in a specified water management area or from a specified water source. However, the holder of a WAL with a zero share component will, like holders of other categories of WAL, be able to trade water allocations and share component units.

The website www.dwe.nsw.gov.au provides more information on water licences.

This application is for a new WAL with a zero share component. If you intend to apply for a new specific purpose WAL, you need to complete a different application form.

Important: A WAL does not permit the use of water for a particular purpose nor does it permit the holder to construct or use a water supply work. Those rights are conferred by a water use approval and a water supply works approval, respectively.

About these guidelines

This application form comprises sections A- G, which are divided into a series of questions. The questions are identified by a number on the left hand side of the page (for example, B4 is question 4 in section B). This guide provides explanations of terms and requirements to help you fill in the application form. We recommend you read this carefully before completing the application form. If you require further assistance, please contact your local Department of Water and Energy water licensing officer.

General instructions

To make sure that your application is processed efficiently please note these general instructions:

- If completing the form in handwriting, please use a black/blue ink pen and use BLOCK letters;
- If there is not enough space on the form for all your information, complete the answer on a separate sheet of paper and attach it to application form (remember to include this page when numbering your pages);
- Ensure that you fully complete the form, as all the information is necessary to verify and process your application – your application may be rejected if all the required information is not provided.

SECTION A: Applicant details

These are the details of the registered holder(s) that will appear on the WAL.

A1-4: The name can be a person's name or the name of a legal entity, such as a corporation. Trading names are not permitted. If the water access licence is to be registered in the names of more than one person, provide the names in the spaces provided. For more than two applicants, provide the additional information on a separate sheet of paper and attach it to the application form.

A5: Insert the Australian Company Number (ACN) if it is a application by a corporation. Note that an ABN (Australian Business Number) is not permitted.

A6: Insert the position of the person(s) who is making the application for and on behalf of the corporation.

A7-11: Insert the usual address of the applicant. If a corporation is applying insert the address details of the corporation's registered office.

A16-23: More than one person can hold one WAL. This form makes provision for 2 applicants. For more than two applicants, provide the information on additional pages and attach to the application form. Each applicant will be a holder of any WAL that might be issued as a result of this application.

A24: This is the total number of applicants to be listed on the WAL (include applicants listed on any additional pages).

SECTION B: Nominate a contact person

In this section, nominate a contact person for enquiries relating to this application.

B1 – B3 and B7-B15: Insert the name and contact details of the nominated contact person.

B4 to B6 only apply to corporations.

B4: Insert the name of the corporation.

B5: Insert ACN of the corporation.

B6: Indicate what position the nominated contact holds in the corporation.

SECTION C: Water access licence tenancy

As a WAL may be held by a number of persons (listed in section A), details of how the WAL is to be divided are required.

C1: Tick the relevant box. Sole holders own 100% of the WAL and the WAL becomes part of that person's estate once they die. Joint Tenants hold the WAL in equal shares and on the death of any one of the Joint Tenants, title vests in the survivor(s). Tenants in Common hold the WAL in defined proportions, not necessarily equal, which may be dealt with independently of the shares of the other Tenant(s) in Common. If a Tenant in Common dies, that holding remains intact and passes to the beneficiary of the deceased's Estate.

C2: If the WAL is to be held by Tenants in Common, specify the percentage of the WAL to be held by each person, eg one person holds 25%, while the other holds 75%. The figures given must add up to 100%.

SECTION D: Water access licence details

Should a water access licence be granted, the share component will be zero. The share component of the WAL is the number of shares in the available water within a water management area or from a water source to which the holders of the WAL are entitled.

D1: Insert the category of WAL you wish to apply for.

D2: Specify the water source - this can be a surface or groundwater source, as specified in the relevant water sharing plan. A WAL with a zero share component must still specify the water management area or water source to which it relates.

D3: If the water sharing plan is divided into zones, please specify the zone that you wish the new WAL to specify.

SECTION E: Nominated work

In the case of a WAL with a zero share component, even if a water supply work is nominated on the WAL, the extraction of water will only be possible if sufficient water allocations have been assigned to the water allocation account for the WAL.

E1: Provide details of all water supply works approvals for all water supply works that are to be nominated on the new WAL, as a work by means of which water credited to the WAL may be taken. Note: For approval(s) with more than one work, you are nominating all water supply works on the approval(s).

E2: Provide the application number if you are currently applying for a water supply work approval for the water supply work/s to be nominated on the WAL being applied for.

SECTION F: Declaration

Please ensure you understand your legal obligations before signing this document. You may need to obtain independent legal advice for this.

F1: Each of the WAL applicants must fill in their name, followed by a signature and the date of signing.

F2: The application is to be signed for and on behalf of the applicant in accordance with section 127 of the *Corporations Act 2001 Cth* (if a company) or by its duly authorised officer (for other types of corporation).

F3 – F4: Corporations must sign in accordance with the provisions of section 127 of the *Corporations Act 2001 (Cth)*.

SECTION G: Declaration of approval holder(s)

The written consent of each holder(s) of a water supply work approval(s) for a water supply work that is nominated in relation to this application is required if the holder is not an applicant to this application.

G1: The approval number is located at the top of the front page of the 'Statement of Approval'.

G2: All the holders of the approval must include their name in block capitals, followed by a signature and the date of signing.

G3: The application is to be signed for and on behalf of the approval holder in accordance with section 127 of the *Corporations Act 2001 Cth* (if a company) or by its duly authorised officer (for other types of corporation).

G3 – G4: Corporations must sign in accordance with the provisions of section 127 of the *Corporations Act 2001 (Cth)*.

Submitting your application

This application must be lodged at a Department of Water and Energy office enclosing a cheque (for the Department of Water and Energy application fee only).

A schedule of fees is available at www.dwe.nsw.gov.au. Alternatively, contact a water licensing officer at a Department of Water and Energy office.

If this application form is incomplete, the application process may be delayed or the application may be refused. Further information may be requested in relation to this application. If the submitted application is complete, it will be registered and the fee processed.
